

Your **Academic Tutorial** will help you to set targets and monitor your progress.


#### MATHS AND ENGLISH


#### **EMPLOYABILITY**

A special WRA programme built into your course to learn the skills for the workplace including:

- CV and interview preparation
- vacancy and application writing
- trips and employer visits
- employer supported projects and activities
- apprenticeship and progression opportunities

From 2 to 9 weeks in length, these often lead to jobs and part-time work alongside your course.





The Technical Level 3 Extended Diploma in Health and Social Care is a two year programme that has been designed to enable learners to access Higher Education or assist with progression into the workplace.

YOU WILL ENTER THE FIELD OF HEALTH AND OR SOCIAL CARE WITH AN INDUSTRY PLACEMENT THAT BEGINS IN OCTOBER AND CONTINUES FOR THE LENGTH OF THE COURSE. THE PLACEMENT TIMINGS WILL BE AGREED ON AN INDIVIDUAL LEVEL, BUT WILL USALLY BE ONE DAY A WEEK FOR THE DURATION OF YOUR PROGREAMME. DURING YOUR PLACEMENT YOU WILL LEARN ABOUT VALUES AND BEHAVIOURS IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE WHILST EXPLORING THE DIFFERENT SETTINGS AND JOB ROLES YOU MAY GO INTO.





- YEAR 1 INCLUDES EQUALITY, HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT, SAFEGUARDING, COMMUNICATION, INFECTION PREVENTION, PSYCHOLOGICAL AND SOCIOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVES IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE.
- YEAR 2 COVERS PROTECTION OF CHILDREN, YOUNG PEOPLE AND ADULTS, ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE, RESEARCH SKILLS FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE...

## Visits and trips





### **Assessment**



- YOU WILL LEARN AND DEVELOP BY COMPLETING PROJECTS AND ASSIGNMENTS THAT ARE BASED ON REALISTIC WORKPLACE SITUATIONS AND ACTIVITIES. WORK PLACEMENTS IN HEALTH AND CARE SETTINGS ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE COURSE AND PROVIDE VALUABLE LINKS BETWEEN THEORY AND PRACTICE.
- THE MAJORITY OF YOUR UNITS ARE INTERNALLY ASSESSED AND GRADED. THERE ARE TWO EXTERNALLY MARKED ASSESSMENTS, ONE IN EACH YEAR OF THE COURSE.
- AN OVERALL GRADE FOR THE QUALIFICATION IS AWARDED AT THE END OF THE COURSE.



## Funding your programme





### The Education & Skills Funding Agency (ESFA)

The Education & Skills Funding Agency funds adult Further Education (FE) and skills training in England. It forms part of a network of organisations in England who commission, manage and promote training for adults and young people. The ESFA funds non-levy Apprenticeships (16yrs +), work placed and classroom based learning programmes throughout England for learners aged 19 and above. If you are enrolled onto an ESFA funded programme this is match funded by the European Social Fund (ESF). The ESFA also funds programmes for individuals aged 14-19 which includes the Study Programme (16-19) and Traineeships (16-18).



### **European Social Fund (ESF)**

You may be enrolled onto a specific ESF project which will be funded by the European Union or if you are engaged onto any of our ESFA programmes, including non levy Apprenticeships, then this will be matched funded by ESF.
